

31st Annual SOURCE AWARDS National Lighting Design Competition

The SOURCE Awards is sponsored annually by Cooper Lighting, focusing on furthering the understanding, knowledge and function of lighting as a primary element of design.

ELIGIBILITY

- The competition is open to all lighting designers, architects, engineers, professional designers and consultants who have used Cooper Lighting fixtures in a completed interior or exterior lighting design project.
- Students currently enrolled in an educational program representing the interior design, architectural, lighting or engineering disciplines are eligible to enter based on a conceptual lighting design project which utilizes Cooper Lighting fixtures. These conceptual entries will be judged in a separate student category.
- Employees of Cooper Lighting including family members, any company and their employees which have a business relationship with Cooper Lighting are excluded from entry into The SOURCE Awards. In addition, any design projects which have been previously used in promotional material developed by Cooper Lighting are excluded.
- Entries must be postmarked before January 1, 2008.
- All entries must be accompanied by an entry form (found in the competition brochure) which can be downloaded from the Cooper Lighting website at www.cooperlighting.com

JUDGING AND AWARDS

Judging for the 31st annual competition will take place in January 2008, by a professional, independent panel of lighting and design professionals as well as a representative of The SOURCE – Cooper Lighting Center.

PROFESSIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- The competition requires the primary and predominant use of any or all Cooper Lighting brands which include Halo, Portfolio, Iris, Metalux, Neo-Ray, Corelite, Sure-Lites, Invue, Lumark, McGraw-Edison, Fail-Safe, Lumière, Shaper, Ametrix and RSA. Entries will be judged on the blending of aesthetics, creative achievement and technical performance and to the degree which the lighting met project constraints and design concept goals.
- Installations completed within the past two years (from the due date for the 2007 submissions) are eligible for submission into 2007 SOURCE Awards program. The project must not have been submitted previously for this competition or used in other Cooper Lighting promotional materials. Entries must be received by January 1, 2008 to be considered.
- Entries are requested in digital format and must meet the following requirements: 3-10 images in a TIF (TIFF), PSD, EPS, or JPG (JPEG) format approximately 8"x10" at 300 resolution on a CD. Please specify whether file is Mac or PC based. 35mm slide format will also be accepted. Entries will not be accepted in e-mail electronic format.
- Entries must comply with IES guidelines and applicable energy and safety codes.
- Images may include relevant details, drawings before/after photos, and daytime photos for exteriors. Any example to help describe/present the unique attributes and lighting solutions.
- Slides or images must be labeled with a number and project name, each to correspond to a keyed description (maximum 50 words per slide).
 Descriptions should include types of fixtures and reasons for selection.
- Summary (250 words maximum) which describes the design concept, challenges, special concerns on the project and the design solution.
- All entries must include a fixture schedule which clearly indicated the use of Cooper Lighting fixtures. Description or notes/comments may be used to detail why and how the Cooper Lighting fixtures were selected or applied.
- In addition to the entry please provide the following information with each entry on a separate cover sheet:
 - Entrant's Name
 - Address
 - Telephone and Fax #s
 - Email address
 - Name of Project
 - Location of Project
 - Size of Project (in dollar value and approximate square footage)
 - Unit power density expressed in watts per square foot or meter
 - Date of Project Completion
 - Design Team/ including non-employees of firm (see eligibility section)
 - Photographer
- * Note: No mention of company names or logo may appear on any part of the presentation with the exception of a separate cover sheet.

STUDENT ENTRIES

- Students may provide their entries on a maximum of (2) presentation boards not to exceed 20" x 30".
- Boards must contain reflected ceiling/lighting, fixture schedule and one page narrative description of the installation and lighting.
- Sketches, renderings or photos of models for the installation concept.
- Attach to the back of the board: entrants name, address, home telephone, e-mail, school name and instructor's name, telephone number and email.
- * Please include a telephone number where the entrant can be reached after January 2008.
- * Note: No student or university name can be displayed on the face of any board.
